In 1954, missionaries returning after World War II established a school under the Church of Christ in Thailand (CCT). We were the first international school registered outside Bangkok.

Curriculum and Standards

CMIS students learn through an American standards-based curriculum that has been thoughtfully adapted by our international team of educators. Using the Understanding by Design approach, teachers create engaging and meaningful units of study that connect learning to real-life experiences. The core subjects of English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies are taught using the following trusted international standards: Common Core State Standards (CCSS), the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS), and the AERO and C3 Social Studies Standards. Our curriculum is designed to challenge students, spark curiosity, and prepare them for success in higher education and in life beyond the classroom.

Preschool

Through creative play, we promote our students' social and emotional development by showing them how to deal with their emotions as well as establish positive relationships and interactions with others.

Subjects: Pre-Reading, Pre-Mathematics, Writing skills, Physical education, Art, Thai language, Music, and library classes outside their regular classroom.

Elementary (KG to Grade 5)

CMIS is dedicated to providing a vibrant, engaging, and student-centered learning environment. Our child-friendly program, with its small class sizes and differentiated instruction, provides each child with the tools required to reach their academic, emotional, and social potential.

Subjects: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Computers, Art, Music, Library, PE, and Thai Language, Culture, and History.

Middle School (Grade 6 to 8)

CMIS Middle School has developed a school model that includes a strong awareness of social-emotional learning through mentor relationships between teachers and students, close-knit learning groups, and community outreach projects.


Subjects: English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and World Languages, while also offering courses in PE, Wellness, Art, Computers, Music, and Drama.



Education Technology

CMIS students in Grades 1 to 2 use iPads to enhance their learning. Chromebooks are provided for students in Grades 2 to 12. CMIS is a phone-free school; to ensure optimal learning, phones are kept in a locked pouch during the school day.





MAP Test

A MAP test (Measures of Academic Progress) is a computerbased, adaptive assessment developed by NWEA to measure student achievement and growth in the core areas of Math, Reading, Language Usage, and Science.

CMIS students in grades 2 to 10 take the MAP Test once a semester to track their academic growth progress.


The chart on the left shows the cumulative 2024-25 scores from CMIS students compared to other international schools in Thailand, East Asia, and IB program schools.

SAT Test

SAT is a standardized test created by the College Board that assesses skills in Reading, Writing, and Math. It provides a uniform benchmark for universities to evaluate and compare applicants from a wide variety of high schools and educational backgrounds. CMIS is an SAT Test Center and hosts 3 tests per semester. CMIS students continuously outperform the worldwide average







After School Activities (ASAs) and Clubs

CMIS's School Activities Program aims to provide a wide variety of opportunities for our students from leadership clubs such as the Student Council (StuCo), National Honor Society(NHS), Model United Nations (MUN), Interact Club, the ECO club, to hobbies clubs such as The Little Chef club, Chess club, Robotics club, Ultimate Frisbee, Thai dance club, Rock Climbing etc.

Athletics

CMIS offers 8 after-school athletic programs (Basketball, Football, Volleyball, Futsal, Swimming, Cross Country, Track&Field, and Badminton) during separate 3 seasons over the course of each school year, with competition with Chiang Mai Athletic Conference (CMAC) member schools as well as local Thai schools.









Student Support Team (SST)

To ensure that our students' needs are met, our CMIS's Student Support Team consists of certified counsellors, Instructional Coaches, a Wellness coach, a Spiritual Advisor, an EAL Coordinator, a College Counselor, an Academic Coordinator, and student support teachers.
